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	<p>offered in seven languages.</p> <p>There is now a sliding scale fee for victim services as well as BIP.</p> <p><u>Rhonda Collins—Probation:</u> Chief John Keene and Probation have been focusing on incorporating evidence-based practices when evaluating service-delivery strategies.</p> <p>Rhonda will be conducting outreach to programs that currently collaborate with Probation to learn more and ensure their service delivery practices also align with evidenced-based practices.</p> <p>BIP Recertification is underway and will conclude in January. Rhonda provided an overview of SMCO standardization and examples of recent site visits.</p> <p><u>Tanisha Hughes—CORA:</u> Referrals are being accepted for Spanish and English support groups. A new Spanish Support Group will be starting on Wednesday evenings in the next 2 weeks. Contact hotline for info.</p> <p>The waitlist for individual counseling is still approx. 2-3 months. The wait for monolingual Spanish referrals is longer given the high demand.</p> <p><u>Paulette Dolin—Shalom Bayit:</u> Extra toys and toiletries available—contact Paulette if interested.</p> <p>Shalom Bayit is ramping up for their fundraising event.</p> <p><u>Sylvia Baez—Keller Center:</u> Increase in physical abuse for CPS cases has led to an increase in forensic interviews at the Keller Center. There are currently only 5 individuals in the county that are qualified to conduct forensic interviews based on new stipulations.</p>

Proposal for TDVAPM in February 2014	<p>Rhonda reported back that she contacted Larry Silver, Deputy Chief Probation Officer to brief him on the potential partnership and he is awaiting a formal proposal.</p> <p>Committee discussed options and potential for partnering with Probation to outreach to the older boys ages 15-18 at the Juvenile Hall. Discussed the possibility of targeting the girls as well, but decided to limit the scope of the initial project given the time constraints and pursue outreach to the girls' camp at a later date. Majority agreed to focus attention on the original request and the need for boys to be engaged in the discussion of healthy relationships and the impact of intergenerational violence.</p> <p>Discussed the theme of healthy relationships and proposed 3rd or 4th week of February for the event. Christina discussed incorporating <i>First Impressions</i> video and Paulette discussed the <i>Love Doesn't Hurt</i> curriculum. The group will share details and finalize program next meeting.</p> <p>Discussed next steps and delegated tasks to identify a possible keynote, draft a proposal, and schedule a meeting with Probation and Juvenile Hall (JH) Management.</p>	<p>Tanisha will draft a proposal based on items discussed and email the group for feedback.</p> <p>Paulette will outreach to Joshua Safran as a potential keynote. Leslie and Rhonda will also outreach for potential keynotes as a contingency plan.</p> <p>Rhonda will provide an intro and facilitate communication between Probation and the CRC co-chairs to schedule the initial meeting.</p> <p>Rhonda, Sylvia, and Tanisha will meet with Probation and JH Management to review the proposal and work out the logistics if approved.</p>
